Following a national search, the HealthImpact Board of Directors is pleased to announce that Dr. Garrett Chan has been chosen to succeed Judee Berg as President and Chief Executive Officer of HealthImpact. In his announcement of the appointment, Board of Directors Chair Dr. Terry Hill stated “The HealthImpact Board of Directors is delighted that Dr. Garrett Chan will be stepping into the CEO role. His leadership experience in both academic and practice settings will enable him to optimize the contribution of HealthImpact and California’s nursing profession toward the much-needed transformation of our nation’s healthcare systems.”

Chan is currently on staff with Stanford Health Care, where he has served as Director for the Center for Education and Professional Development and Director of Advanced Practice. He earned his PhD and MS in Nursing and completed Post-Masters work as an Acute Care Nurse Practitioner at the University of California, San Francisco. He was a Fellow at the National

Institutes of Health's Summer Genetics Program, and completed the American College of Health Executives Senior Executive Program in Healthcare Administration. Chan states "I look forward to building on the organization's strong relationships with other state and national organizations and advancing the next steps for nursing to meet the evolving needs in healthcare and the nursing workforce. I am eager to take a leadership role in enhancing the organization's impact and creating new programs to improve the health of Californians, the healthcare system, and nursing practice and leadership."
