Pathways to Leadership Empowerment, the 4th Annual Minority Nurse Summit, took place Sep. 15, 2018 in Fresno, California. Pilar de la Cruz and Nancy Hoff of HealthImpact's Diversity Network put together another phenomenal program with nationally recognized speakers. This daylong event has been the foundation of HealthImpact's ongoing diversity meetings across the state. Seven Regional Nursing Summits Address Gaps in Pre-Licensure RN Clinical Education Capacity

In September and October 2018, nursing summits were held in Oakland, San Diego, Los Angeles, Sacramento, Fresno, Irvine, and Riverside, California, with the goal of identifying practical solutions to address the pre-licensure nursing clinical placement issues that California is currently experiencing. Recognizing the current environment and changing models of care, action steps generated at each meeting will directly address local needs.

Southern California Regional Nursing Workforce Forums Address the Need to Develop RNs in Hospital Specialty Areas

The Hospital Association of Southern California conducted regional nursing workforce forums in partnership with HealthImpact and the Health Workforce Initiative in the Inland Empire and in Los Angeles in October and November. A third session is scheduled for December 10 in Orange County. The forums enable academic and practice leaders from hospitals and nursing schools to discuss strategies to address the shortage of experienced specialty RNs. The HealthImpact model of developing specialty RNs through courses conducted by schools of nursing as academic-practice collaboratives in partnership with area hospitals is being shared, with the goal of supporting expansion as part of an overall regional plan.

2017 National Nursing Workforce Survey Results Released

Since 2013, the National Council of State Boards of Nursing (NCSBN) and the National Forum of State Nursing Workforce



Centers (Forum) have partnered every 2 years to conduct a national sample survey using the Forum's Nurse Supply Minimum Data Set (MDS), a standardized survey tool designed to collect workforce data. The results of the 2017 National Workforce Survey have been published in the October 2018 *Journal of Nursing Regulation*, and represent a sample of approximately 3,844,410 RNs and 934,395 LPN/LVNs.
