

How To Prepare For Your COVID-19 Assignment: A checklist for volunteers, students, and licensed healthcare professionals

WHAT TO CONSIDER WHEN RESPONDING TO COVID-19

- ☐ Review benefits and risks for clinicians and students in responding to the COVID-19 emergency
- ☐ How to adjust from usual standards of care to crisis standards of care
- ☐ Seek guidance and receive direction from a supervising licensed health care professional

STUDENTS: HOW TO WORK WITH YOUR ACADEMIC PROGRAM

- ☐ Review your student handbook and obtain documents provided through your academic program administration
- ☐ Contact the nursing program you are enrolled in for further information regarding potential for receiving academic credit for clinical coursework, work study or independent study options

PREPARING FOR AN ASSIGNMENT

- ☐ Understand your role, key functions and limitations, and responsibilities within the team
- ☐ Inquire about and clarify key functions that require prior authorization, or direct supervision to be carried out
- ☐ Seek clarification often and request assistance as needed

QUALIFICATIONS AND CREDENTIALING

- ☐ Provide documentation as requested for approval and clearance for volunteer or paid work assignment. This may include health screening, background check, evidence of experience and competencies, BLS card
- ☐ Once cleared, contact the clinical site, complete orientation requirements and competency validation as identified and applicable to role and level of practice
- ☐ Confirm location and scheduling, report as assigned

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STUDENT SCOPE OF PRACTICE

- ☐ Nursing services delivered by students are competency-based, within the overall scope and level defined by the Board of Registered Nursing.
- □ Obtain your Skills Competency Checklist from the nursing program you are enrolled in as evidence of current competency
- ☐ Provide a copy of your *Skills Competency* Checklist during the recruitment process
- ☐ Bring a copy of your *Skills Competency* Checklist and course syllabus with course learning objectives and student learning outcomes with you to the practice site.
- ☐ Review information on various patient population/acuity levels

DIRECTION AND SUPERVISION

Students assigned through their nursing programs should:

- ☐ Obtain information and guidance regarding clinical site location, scheduling, and preassignment preparation from your nursing program
- ☐ Seek direction and obtain supervision from the academic faculty or designated RNs identified when providing patient care or services

Students assigned through/by an organization outside of their nursing programs should:

- ☐ Obtain information and guidance regarding clinical site location, scheduling and preassignment preparation directly from the organization that assigned you
- ☐ Verify who (RN or licensed professional) the clinical designates to provide direction and supervision to you when providing patient care or services

STATE OF EMERGENCY AND **COMMUNITY AWARENESS**

- ☐ Be aware of the status of COVID-19 in your area; follow state and public health guidelines within the community https://covid19.ca.gov http://cdph.ca.gov/covid19
- ☐ Check the County Health Department website where you live or work in for more specific details
- ☐ Inform patients and families regarding state and public health guidelines, provide education, and validate regarding control and prevention

PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF COVID-19 TRANSMISSION

- ☐ Review and be aware of steps to prevent exposure and transmission of COV ID-19 in the community
- ☐ Review and adopt specific practices for healthcare professionals working directly with populations that have or are suspected to have COVID-19

USE OF PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT (PPE)

- ☐ Review proper use of PPE for respiratory transmission applicable to health care personnel
- ☐ Familiarize yourself with different types of PPE and levels of protection as supplies from various vendors may be used

PATIENT ASSESSMENT AND CARE

☐ Self-assess your current knowledge and experience caring for patients with respiratory illnesses, identify your learning needs
